NEW ADDRESS AND ORGANIZATIONAL UPDATES

Woman, Cradle of Abundance was originally named FEBA, Inc., using Woman, Cradle of Abundance as an alternate name. We have now applied to the IRS to be officially Woman, Cradle of Abundance, with the same EIN 90-0945617.

For convenience we shorten this to "CRADLE." Women's traditional work is cradling children. However, "Cradle" is also a metaphor for nurturing life in many ways & circumstances. We "cradle" & open doors to social justice for girls & women & children through education, income-generating activities, & support for victims of gender violence & destitution.

This USA nonprofit works with two small Congo nonprofits: FEBA in Kinshasa, CENEDI in Kivu (eastern Congo). For each Congo partner there is a CRADLE department. One of these, called Hands Across the Water (HAW), is the "youth division" which aims both to open more global perspectives for North American students & to educate destitute children in Congo.

CRADLE will be 10 years old in Feb. 2023! In preparation for this big event we are working to make a solid base for the future. One change is a NEW address.
